

**Intra specific Biodiversity of woodpecker *Dinopium benghalense*, Linnaeus 1758 in District Jamshoro, Sindh, Pakistan**

**Abstract:**

During the present studies total of 07 woodpecker specimens have been recorded from different localities of District Jamshoro, Sindh, Pakistan. In all, 07 specimens were recovered viz: 07 specimens of *Dinopium benghalense* 03 (♀♀) and 04 (♂♂) were recorded. Present species shows diversification with respect to weight of body; length of body; length of head; length of tail; length of crown, length of feathers, length of legs, length of beak, length of wings, No; of plumage, No; of coverlets of wings, No of tail feathers, No of tail coverlets, Diameters of eyes, color of eyes, color of wings in body and color of woodpecker respectively.
